GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF PAPERS

The organizing committee invites you to present your research work.

Following are the categories of award papers.

Dr Benakappa award for research in General pediatrics

Dr Boppiah award for research in Social pediatrics

Dr P.N. Krishnamurthy award for research in Hemato-oncology

Dr Paramesh H award for research done by practicing pediatricians

Candidates do not need to mention the award category except for practicing pediatricians. All the papers will be assessed for their potential to be included in the platform presentation for respective award in each category.

The research work that is of similar quality but does not qualify for the award paper presentation will be grouped under free papers for platform presentation.

Free papers will be grouped into the following categories.

- Infectious disease/Immunology
- Hemodynamics and intensive care
- Respiratory and allergy
- General category


The winners in this group will be awarded 'certificate of merit' by the organizing committee of KARPEDICON 2024

Scientific committee may suggest some of the research work to be presented as Posters. Authors may send their work for poster presentation directly which will be assessed separately from the platform presentation papers.

The standards for posters displayed at the conference will be announced later.

Terms and conditions for the submission of the research work

- * Research work must be original and must not have been published or presented in any other meeting.
- Multiple submissions from the same author or the research team is acceptable
- Manuscripts should be submitted through online mode only.
- ◆ Candidates should indicate if the submission is for poster or paper presentation.
- Practicing pediatricians sending their research work for platform presentation should clearly indicate the same.
- Manuscript should be uploaded only in MS Word (.doc or .docx) format.
- ◆ No correspondence will be entertained unless asked by the Scientific Committee.
- ◆ The manuscript submitted will go through a jury review and reviewed by the scientific committee.
- The Scientific Committee reserves the right to make the final decision regarding the acceptance of any paper and also their mode of presentation.
- The presenting author is solely responsible for informing the other Co-Authors about the status of the abstract.
- If your research work is selected for the presentation during the conference, you will be informed by e-mail. Further details will be updated by e-mail on selection.



Guidelines for submission of research work



General

Microsoft word format. Other formats such as .odt etc. are not acceptable.

Font: Calibri (body)12

Spacing 1.5 or 2. Do not leave space after a paragraph.

Word count: Maximum 700 for platform presentation and 250 for poster presentation

Language: English

Standard abbreviations may be used without definition.

The abbreviations should be expanded in the article at first instance.

Flow of presentation

First page

The name of the authors, their designation, academic/professional affiliations should be presented along with email and phone number of corresponding author Include the following statement in the first page

"I/We confirm that the abstract and that all information provided is correct.

I/We accept that the content of this abstract cannot be modified or corrected after final submission, and I/we am/are aware that it will be presented exactly as submitted.

Submission of the abstract constitutes my consent to publication as the conference abstract.

I/We are the sole owner/s or have the right to all information and content provided.

I/We herewith confirm that the contact details provided are those of the corresponding author, who will be notified about the status of the abstract."

I/We confirm that there is no conflict of interest to declare (if present you need to declare that here) Details funding for the study

Subsequent pages

Background/Introduction:

The relevant information leading to the need for the study.

Need for the study:

This should be a separate paragraph immediately after the background section.

This is an argument and not a mere statement. The need for the study should generally

lead to the primary objective. The authors may wish to add their study hypothesis in this section.

Objectives:

It is essential to have only one primary objective. This can be followed by multiple secondary objectives as deemed necessary.

Materials and Methods:

This is the most important part of the study.

Frame your section in the following subsections.

Study design (PICOT format wherever applicable) Sampling method and size

Execution of the study (the model and make of the instruments to be mentioned as appropriate) Statistical analysis including the statistical tests used.



Results:

Present the main results with appropriate statistics.

Two tables and two figures are allowed along with the narrative result.

Tables should have both horizontal and vertical lines. Column headers should be in bold. and foot notes can be added wherever appropriate.

Figures, graphs, and illustrations should be either in .png or .jpg format.

Discussion:

Discussion should be concise and relevant to the set objectives of the study.

Authors are advised not to tease the data with an intention of making the writeup bulkier.

In case if a hypothesis is generated or authors foresee a grand outcome if their study results are generalizable, it can be discussed in the last but one paragraph of the discussion section.

The last paragraph of the discussion should be on the limitations of the study.

Conclusion:

Conclusion should strictly be scientific and should be supported by the results of the study. Extrapolation of the data and speculations are not acceptable.

References:

A maximum of 10 references for platform presentation and 5 references for poster presentation are allowed. Please cite most relevant articles only.

Avoid citation of the article which is published more than 10 yrs ago unless it is absolutely needed. References should be in the 'Indian pediatrics' format.
